## Overnight Uluru Camping Safari

### Day 1 : Kata Tjuta and Uluru

We make our start exploring the intriguing landforms of Kata Tjuta (the Olgas) and hiking the Valley of the Winds. Uluru (Ayers Rock) is spectacular, and we get there in time to see the rich desert colours changing as the sun sets, with a glass of sparkling wine to top it off! A hearty dinner and some star-gazing at our permanent campsite is the perfect way to end the evening. (D)

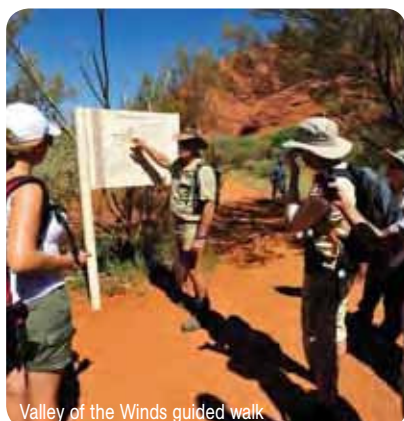
### Day 2 : Uluru

It's an early start this morning, but it's definitely worth getting up for sunrise at Uluru. Explore the mysterious rock formations and Aboriginal art sites around the base. Deepen your understanding of the land and its stories at the Cultural Centre, where you have the chance to admire and purchase Indigenous arts and crafts, before returning to Ayers Rock Resort at 12 noon. (B)

**Bring:** Sturdy walking shoes (ankle high), hat and sunscreen, water bottle, toiletries, torch, warm clothing in winter months, insect repellent/net and camera.

**Included:** Experienced tour guide, meals as indicated, camping fees, camping equipment (twin share tents with proper beds, all linen, pillows, towels and fans).

**Note:** \*Flights must arrive before 1.20pm to connect with Yulara Airport Shuttle (free 6km transfer) to Desert Gardens Hotel. Please arrive in appropriate touring clothing and footwear with a day pack prepared. ^ Flights must depart after 1.30pm. Please advise flight details at time of booking.

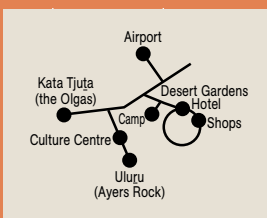

## 1.5-2 Day Red Centre Highlights

### Day 1 : Alice Springs to Kings Canyon and Uluru

Kick off your Red Centre adventure as we travel through ranges and an ancient river to Kings Canyon. There's a bit of exploring to do here: the monumental North and South Walls, the Amphitheatre, the Lost City and the lush, inviting Garden of Eden. From here we head to another ancient landform, Uluru (Ayers Rock) where we stay overnight in our private campsite at Ayers Rock Resort. (LD)

### Day 2 : Uluru to Alice Springs

Sunrise at Uluru is worth the early start! Take a stroll part way around the base and discover mystifying rock formations and Aboriginal art sites. Be fascinated by the red domes of Kata Tjuta (the Olgas), then return to Yulara where airport and resort drop offs are available before lunch. (B) Or remain aboard and travel back to Alice Springs. (L)

**Bring:** Sturdy walking shoes (ankle high), hat and sunscreen, water bottle, toiletries, torch, warm clothing in winter, insect repellent/net, camera, sleeping bag (can be hired for AUD\$20) and pillow.

**Included:** Experienced tour guide, meals as indicated, accommodation transfers in Alice Springs, camping fees and equipment.

**Note:** Flights must depart Yulara Airport after 2.00pm. Please advise your flight details at time of booking. Lunch not included for passengers departing at Ayers Rock Resort. The 'Rim Walk' at Kings Canyon may be substituted with the 'Creek Walk' when temperatures are extreme.

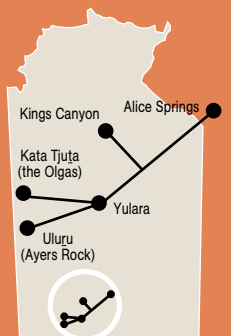
