### Swim with sea-lions and dolphins

#### Baird Bay \$150 per person

This is an amazing experience - you may have swum with dolphins at other places around the world but the interaction that you will have with the sea-lions and dolphins at Baird Bay will leave you breathless. The tour is 3-4 hours, wetsuit and snorkel equipment is provided at no additional cost.

### Cage dive with great white sharks

#### Port Lincoln \$495 per person

The first one day shark tour in Australia - all meals and drinks are included. Sharks are easily visible from the boat and each person will spend a minimum of 30 minutes in the actual cage. When booked through Nullarbor Traveller - a wetsuit and video highlights package is also included in the price (normal value \$75.00)

If booking through a travel agent, Nullarbor Traveller has contractual arrangements with all international and domestic (within Australia) travel agents. Our Cancellation Policy clearly states that cancellation 14 days or more prior to departure will incur a 20% cancellation fee, between 14 days and 7 days will incur a 50% cancellation fee and cancellation within 7 days or failing to board will incur a 100% cancellation fee.

### What Accommodation, Vehicles and Facilities are used?

Our vehicles are 21 seater deluxe air conditioned Toyota coaster buses with a maximum of 18 people (between Coodlie Park and Esperance)..

Accommodation on the tour is a mixture of national parks, camp grounds, bush camps [no facilities] and farm retreat.

When camping, we use individual swags. (Our wet weather option is 3 person dome tents with a maximum of 2 people per tent)
