Kata Tjuta Valley of the Winds Walk, Sunset and Barbecue Dinner Code: Y14

Highlights: • Valley of the Winds Walk
• Barbecue Dinner

Your guide will escort you on a 2-3 hour walk through the Kata Tjuta domes to the Valley of the Winds lookout. The walking path is rocky, and requires a good level of fitness. After the walk, take in the magnificent outback sunset over Kata Tjuta. Refresh yourself with a complimentary glass of sparkling wine. Travel to our exclusive venue to enjoy a Australian barbecue dinner consisting of steak, sausages, kangaroo meat, salads and bread with complimentary Australian sparkling wine. There is time for stargazing too (weather permitting). Enquire about vegetarian meals at time of booking. **D**

Uluru Sunrise and Base Tour Code: Y17

Highlights: • Uluru (Ayers Rock)
• Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre

Travel to the Uluru sunrise viewing area, Talinguru nyakunytyaku, to see the Red Centre set alight by the first rays of the sun. Enjoy a cup of tea or coffee and biscuits as the colours of Uluru gradually change as the sun rises on the horizon. Tour the base of Uluru, including a guided walk into Mutitjulu Waterhole. View Aboriginal rock paintings and learn about the flora, fauna and Aboriginal history from your Driver/Guide. Continue around the base of Uluru by coach and see various sacred areas. Visit the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre where there is time to read the Tjukurpa (Aboriginal law) or purchase some locally made Aboriginal art.

Highlights: • Sunset at Uluru (Ayers Rock) • Uluru - Kata Tjuta National Park

Travel from Ayers Rock Resort to the Uluru sunset viewing area. Enjoy nibbles and a complimentary glass of wine as the sun sinks over the western horizon and the evening sky brings out the many shades of colour for which Uluru is famous. Don't forget your camera! It is recommended that you photograph Uluru every 5 minutes to really capture the gradual colour changes of the rock. Occasionally, when it rains you may be lucky enough to see the spectacular sight of water cascading over the sides of Uluru.

Highlights: • Walpa Gorge Walk
• Sunset at Uluru (Ayers Rock)

Travel to the mystical 36 domes of Kata Tjuta. On the way, stop at a lookout for a panoramic view of the southern side of Kata Tjuta. Continue on before arriving at the base of Walpa Gorge. Spend some time exploring the gorge and the unusual conglomerate rock formations. The walking trail through Walpa Gorge follows the natural creek between two of the tallest domes of Kata Tjuta. In the late afternoon we travel to the Uluru sunset viewing area. Witness and photograph the striking colour changes of Uluru at sunset while enjoying nibbles and a complimentary glass of wine.

Highlights: • Kata Tjuta (the Olgas)
• Valley of the Winds Walk

Travel to Kata Tjuta (the Olgas) where your Driver/Guide will explain the geological history of these giant domes. Your Driver/Guide will then escort you on a 2-3 hour walk in the valley between the massive red conglomerate rock. The walking path is rocky and requires a good level of fitness. Marvel at the unique flora and fauna that has survived in this harsh environment. When you reach the Valley of the Winds Lookout, take some time to gaze out over the central valley of Kata Tjuta. Then take in a magnificent outback sunset at Kata Tjuta while enjoying a complimentary glass of sparkling wine.

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Uluru & Kata Tjuta Sightseeing

Uluru Sunrise, Climb and Base Tour Code: Y18

Highlights: • Sunrise at Uluru (Ayers Rock) • Mutitjulu Walk • Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre

Rise early this morning to travel to the Uluru sunrise viewing area, Talinguru nyakunyjtaku. Watch the first rays of the sun set the Red Centre alight while enjoying a warming cup of tea or coffee and biscuits. For those with a good level of fitness there is the opportunity to climb Uluru. Alternatively, non-climbers can choose to take a peaceful stroll along the Mala Walk (non-guided), which winds among the bloodwood trees alongside Uluru. After the climb, join your AAT Kings Driver/Guide for a tour around the base of Uluru. Travel by coach to the Mutitjulu Walk where you will be escorted to the beautiful Mutitjulu Waterhole. View Aboriginal rock paintings and learn about the area as your Driver/Guide points out some native flora and explains the Aboriginal and European history of Uluru. Visit the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre, where you can learn about Aboriginal culture and see Aboriginal arts and crafts, before returning to Ayers Rock Resort.

Visit the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre, where you can learn about Aboriginal culture and Tjukurpa (Aboriginal law). There is also the opportunity to purchase Aboriginal arts and crafts. Travel to the Uluru sunset viewing area. Enjoy nibbles and a complimentary glass of wine as the sun sinks over the western horizon and the evening sky brings out the many shades of colour for which Uluru is renowned. Occasionally, when it rains, you may be lucky enough to see the spectacular sight of water cascading over the sides of Uluru. Return to Ayers Rock Resort.
