1 Day Uluru (Ayers Rock) from Alice Springs

The highlights include Uluru, Kata Tjuta, The Visitor Centre and Champagne BBQ sunset dinner at the rock. What to bring:	Tour voucher and 1.5 litre water bottle, strong, non-slip walking shoes, hats, sunglasses, camera & sunscreen. Dress in the Northern Territory is casual and comfortable. Winter nights (May to August) are cold, so bring warm clothing. Days are sunny and warm. Summer (Nov-Feb) is hot, so cool light clothing is best.

ITINERARY:

We collect you from outside your Alice Springs accommodation at 6am, a light breakfast on board our comfortable air conditioned coach then stop at Eralunda Roadhouse and Aboriginal art display.

Uluru is located in the 1,325-hectare Uluru – Kata Tjuta National Park. The park is World-Heritage listed for the importance of its natural phenomena and its cultural significance. Our friendly, experienced guides show you the outback world they love.

ULURU – 100 storeys high & 9.4 kms around – one of the most spectacular sights you'll ever see. We arrive at Uluru around midday and stop at the Visitors Centre (warmer months). We have lunch and travel to Kata Tjuta (Olgas). Back to Uluru and visit the Aboriginal Cultural Centre. We do guided walks at Uluru (The order of this part of the itinerary may change between hotter and cooler months). A BBQ & Champagne Dinner watching a Magnificent Central Australian Sunset on Uluru is a highlight of this great day.

We depart for Alice Springs after sunset, arriving back approx midnight in cooler months and 1.00am warmer months. (Comfortable coach seats are great for a sleep on the way home).
