

TOUR DETAILS AND ITINERARY

1 Day start and finish at Uluru (Ayers Rock)

HIGHLIGHTS:

Spend the night in a swag (Aussie bedroll) watching the sun rise and set over Uluru after spending a day walking around the base of the big rock and setting out on a hike of nearby Kata Tjuta (The Olgas). Learn a bit of local history with an Uluru Cultural Experience. This tour starts and ends at Ayers Rock and will be a two day experience you won't forget.

ITINERARY:

Day 1 - Kata Tjuta and Uluru

PICK UP LOCATION: Desert Gardens Hotel, 1:45pm**

We make our start exploring the intriguing landforms of Kata Tjuta (the Olgas) and hiking through the spectacular Valley of the Winds. Marvel at the sheer size and depth of colour that makes Uluru such an impressive site, especially as we get there in time to see the rich desert tones changing as the sun sets. Relax and enjoy the view with some Australian sparkling wine. A hearty dinner and some star-gazing at our permanent campsite is the perfect way to end the evening. **(D)**

Day 2 - Uluru

Rise early today and watch a breathtaking sunrise over Uluru. Enjoy an unguided walk around the vast base of Uluru. You will then deepen your understanding of the land and the Mala people as you take a cultural

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interpretive walk with an Aboriginal guide (and interpreter)*. Afterwards, you will have the opportunity to purchase Aboriginal arts and crafts at the Cultural Centre before your tour finishes at Ayers Rock Resort. **(B)**

Tours departing on and after October 6th:
